Terre Bianchi, Pigato 2012 Riviera Ligure di Ponente 17 Drink 2013-2017

Soft, shiny straw yellow. Earthier and deeper on the nose than the Vermentino although it is the same grape. More concentration and less upfront too. Full-bodied feel.

Fine citric acidity and clean tangy grapefruit finish. (WS) 13%

Terre Bianchi Vermentino 2012 Riviera Ligure di Ponente 16.5 Drink 2013-2015

Straw yellow. Quite yeasty on the nose, then soft yellow fruit jelly. Spritzy, fresh and ripe and succulent. Lemony finish. Quite vibrant and well balanced with its 13%.

Wonderful aperitif. (WS) 13%

Terre Bianchi 2012 Rossese di Dolceacqua 16.5 Drink 2013-2016

Youthful, and just mid ruby. Lifted strawberry and raspberry with a dark spicy undertone. Quite fragrant strawberry fruit with a soft tannic bite. Only just mid bodied.

Unpretentious and delicious. Original. (WS) 13%
